The Safety and Security Department monitors and responds to all emergencies 24x7. The CCTV is in operation in school campus and is being monitored and recorded for the purposes of crime prevention / misbehavior, the prevention from bullying, for the safety of our staff and students and for the protection of school property. This system is in operation round the clock, every day.

Our school students are subjected to a strict dress code. School takes a strong stand against drug and alcohol abuse, along with a zero tolerance policy towards bullying. A school counselor is available to assist troubled students. Common injuries are handled in-house by a full-time Nurse, whereas, illnesses are promptly communicated to the Parents.
